Tour at the Solidarity Museum in the Gdansk Shipyard and the Monument of the Fallen Gdansk Shipyard Workers from the year 1970.

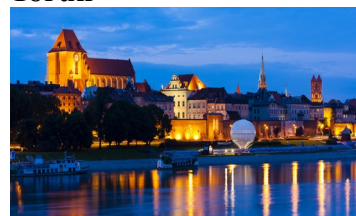


4th day	Gdansk – Malbork – Toruń - Gdańsk

10.00	Visit at the Malbork Castle Museum, the biggest brick castle in the world. The Teutonic Order started to build it in 1380. This monument is inscribed on UNESCO's List of Human Heritage.
13.00	Lunch at a restaurant near the castle.
14.00	Departure Toruń. Guided tour of Toruń, a medieval town listed as The World Heritage site by UNESCO. Visiting the house of Copernicus, the most famous Polish astronomer. Sightseeing at a cathedral built in the years 1250-1500, as well as the fortified walls with the Leaning Tower.
18.00	Departure for Gdansk.
20.00	Arrival in Gdańsk. Dinner at a restaurant in the city or at the hotel. Overnight in Gdansk.
5th day	Departure from Poland.
x	Breakfast at the hotel. Check-out from the hotel.
y	Transfer to the airport. Departure from Poland.
